## From the Old Charges

In the **Charges** (of 1723) under the sub-heading 'Concerning God and Religion' and printed in the first Book of Constitutions, approved by the Grand Lodge in 1723, is stated:

*A Mason is oblig'd, by his Tenure, to obey the moral Law; and if he rightly understands the Art, he will never be a stupid Atheist, nor an irreligious Libertine. But though in ancient Times, Masons were charg'd in every Country to be of the Religion of that Country or Nation, whatever it was, yet 'tis now thought more expedient only to oblige them to that particular Religion in which all men agree, leaving their particular Opinions to themselves; that is, to be good Men and true, or Men of Honour and Honesty, by whatever Denom-inations or Persuasions that may be distinguish'd; whereby Masonry becomes the Center of Union; and the Means of conciliating true Friendship among Persons that must have remain'd at a perpetual Distance.*
