I wanted to take this opportunity to update you on several of the initiatives we have in progress.

### The Building

The building Trustees have employed Mr. Richard Chesbro, Structural Engineer, to begin engineering and construction documents for the reinforcement of the second and third floors to meet the current code requirements for floor loading. Structural issues related to the roof and lateral support of the exterior wall system will also be addressed as part of the floor reinforcement design.
